IN-PERSON PARTICIPATION

The Call to Action Partner Meeting will run on Day 1 9:30 – 17:00 and Day 2 from 9:00 – 17.00. **Please arrive well in time** at the UN-CITY. The venue can be accessed from 8.30 AM. **Bring photo ID to the meeting – without ID, access cannot be granted.**

VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION

Online participation will be through Zoom. There is one main meeting link for the plenary sessions on Day 1 and another link for the plenary sessions for day 2. The links are provided in the programme. Separate links will be provided for the respective breakout sessions. The online breakout sessions will be entirely online in order to ensure best quality interaction.

During the plenary sessions all online participants will be projected on a screen in the main auditorium and the chat will be open for interaction in order to ensure as much involvement as possible. The chat will be continuously monitored and it will thus be possible to pose questions.

The meeting takes place in Denmark, Copenhagen at the UN City located at Marmorvej 51, 2100. The meeting is hosted by UNFPA in Auditorium 3 and meeting rooms opposite the cantina.



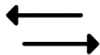
PHOTO ID

TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT

Copenhagen Airport (CPH) is located only 8 km outside Copenhagen city centre. From the airport, you can use taxi, bus, metro or train to reach the city centre. You can find the busses, metro and trains in Terminal 3.

The metro is the easiest and quickest way to reach the city centre, as it runs 24/7 and takes only about 15 minutes. Tickets for the metro can be purchased at the airport in Terminal 3.

You can find taxis outside Terminal 1 and 3. With taxi you will reach the city centre in 20-30 minutes for the price of around 250-350 DKK (€34-47).

You can purchase a "City Pass Small" (150 DKK / €20 for 48 hours) to enjoy unlimited travel on buses, trains and metro all day and all night. You can buy the City Pass electronically on the DOT Ticket app, or physically in the ticket vending machines. Please find more information on www.visitcopenhagen.com

TRANSPORTATION TO UN-CITY

If you are planning on travelling directly from the airport to UN-City you can travel by metro: M2 towards 'Vanløse' and change to M4 towards 'Orientkaj' at station 'Kongens Nytorv' and get off at station 'Nordhavn' and then walk for 800 meters to reach UN-City. The approximate travel time is 45 minutes.

If you are going to UN-City from Copenhagen Central Station you can take the train A, B, C and E and get off at station 'Nordhavn' or you can take the metro M4 towards 'Orientkaj' and get off at 'Nordhavn'. The approximate travel time is 25 minutes.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION
