## Assessment

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### Required

- Referral Pathway
- Services
- Voluntary Participation

### Dealbreaker

- Major Security Threat
- Active Targeting of Service Providers

## Logistics

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### Coordination

- Led by lead coordination agency for that emergency
- Integrated into GBV SOP template

### Timeline

- In the first 1–3 months following the emergency onset

## GBV Data in Acute Emergencies Toolkit (Still Under Development)

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- Self-administered training module
- Minimum Data Set (optional intake form)
- Basic Excel-based Analysis & Compilation Tool
- Standard template ISP (2 page – risk reduction)
